Based on your assertion that Crimson Power Solutions ("CRIMSON") is applying with the State of Pennsylvania to operate as a natural gas broker/marketer, UGI Utilities, Inc. ("UGIU") has concluded that CRIMSON will not need to post security with UGI Utilities, Inc. – South Rate District ("UGI South"), UGI Utilities, Inc. – North Rate District ("UGI North") or UGI Utilities, Inc. – Central Rate District ("UGI Central"). 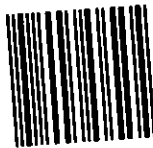
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
