Dear Lauren M. Lepkoski:

We respectfully deny the prehearing, which is scheduled for 9:00 AM, Friday, February 1, 2019. We did not realize that the Metropolitan Edison Company requested a prehearing conference. We re-read their Answer and saw the request after the fact. We apologize this detail was overlooked; we are not attorneys and therefore are finding the legal process of our complaint to be laborious.

Furthermore, we object to Met-Ed's Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents. Many of the questions proposed do not pertain to our complaint. Many questions are invasive to our privacy or have nothing to do with the issue at hand. In addition, it is not humanly possible to accumulate all the answers that are requested in the time frame demanded. We also feel that most of Met-Ed's questions are not appropriate.

We are requesting an in-person hearing. If any questions are to be answered beforehand, we are requesting more time. It is difficult to determine, however, how much time would be necessary since that would depend on the questions. It would not be possible for us to submit answers to the current questions proposed within 20 days. We both work full time, and care for a child and an elderly parent full time. Therefore, both the kinds of questions and the time frame given are unfair. In addition, it would also be very difficult for us to meet the deadlines for the Interim Order Establishing Initial Litigation Schedule.



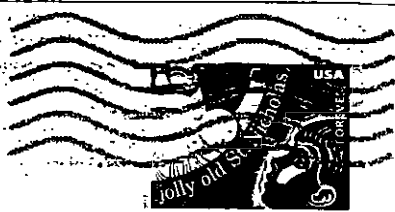
