Dear Judge Barnes:

On or about December 17, 2019, Thomas Maslar (“Complainant”) requested that the in-person hearing scheduled for February 8, 2019, be continued because he would be at work that day and he wanted additional time “to receive, compile and study new information” related to the complaint. Since that time, PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) has been trying to work with the Complainant to develop an alternative date for the hearing.

On January 18, 2019, the Complainant and I spoke about some dates that the Company could potentially be available for a rescheduled hearing. The parties tentatively agreed that May 28, 2019, would work, subject to confirmation with PPL Electric. Thereafter, the Company determined that its expert witnesses would need to appear by telephone at an in-person hearing held on May 28, 2019. On January 28 and February 5, 2019, I left voicemails for the Complainant explaining that PPL Electric could agree to an in-person hearing on May 28, 2019, if its expert witnesses appeared by telephone. As of the filing of this letter, I have not heard back from the Complainant.

To avoid further delay, PPL Electric hereby respectfully requests that the in-person hearing be rescheduled for May 28, 2019, on the condition that its expert witnesses be permitted to appear by telephone. Counsel for PPL Electric and its other witnesses will be appear in person at the hearing.
