Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

By Secretarial Letter issued on January 24, 2019, the Commission ordered that exceptions in this docket are due on February 13, 2019. This morning, PECO was e-served with Ms. Caesar's letter, dated February 11 but filed with the Commission this morning, in which she requests a continuance for an unspecified period of time to file her exceptions.

PECO does not object to a reasonable continuance, but does not believe that a continuance for an unspecified period is feasible or good practice. The original period for filing exceptions was 20 days. PECO respectfully suggests that the maximum extension that the Commission should consider granting is an additional 20 days, which doubles the period normally provided for exceptions. That would set a new due date of Tuesday, March 5, 2019 for exceptions. Reply exceptions would then be due 10 days later, on Friday, March 15, 2019.
