Dear Ms Chiavetta,

I have received your adjudication of the case #C – 2018 – 3000900 RE: "Peter Mimmo vs PECO Energy".

I have read the opinion 3 times and I do not see any information related to why I was not able to attend my hearings. The fact is that PECO contacted me via telephone and advised me "*it was not necessary to attend the court hearing. It can be handled thru a conference call*".

Each time I called PECO – at the number and time requested – I WAS UNABLE TO CONNECT TO THE CONFERENCE.

THEREFORE, AFTER BEING TOLD NOT TO COME TO THE HEARING IN CENTER CITY BY PECO AND BEING UNABLE TO "CONNECT" TO THE CONFERENCE CALL – THE OPINION READS THAT I JUST NEGLECTED TO SHOW UP. (Which is the furthest thing from the truth).

I took the time to make the complaint after years of the same issues with PECO / EXELON. I received a court date and had arranged my schedule to be in court.

I am disappointed that the PUC, an agency created to protect the consumer due to lack of competition, has taken the side of PECO.


Nowhere in this opinion is the stated facts from the complainant, Mr. Mimmo, that PECO advised me not to go to the hearing or that the numbers given to the consumer were not operating numbers. In addition, I have lost the power to make an additional complaint after getting NO resolution to my original complaint.

I have received your attached response to my concerns about not getting a hearing date for my PUC complaint.

I took the time to make the complaint after years of the same issues with PECO / EXELON. I received a court date and had arranged my schedule to be in court.

PECO contacted me about a "conference call" to resolve the dispute or at least "get it on the record". Every time I called in the number PECO gave me I was unable to connect. I saved the phone messages which referred to me as " Mr Mendez".

I want to face PECO regarding the lack of continuous reliable utility service for my area. We have had so many outages it is too high to count. Everybody is buying generators.

While I understand that emergencies occur this situation is well beyond "normal". I will be requesting to purchase service from an alternate utility who is committed to reliable service and emergency response when a problem occurs.

I am a everyday citizen, not a lawyer. I don't know what "exceptions" are or how to "serve" all parties. PECO ran the clock out on me to avoid a record of bad service.

It is disappointing that the PUC is covering for a failing utility that is NOT serving the needs of our community.

In the future I will not complain to the PUC and I will suffer with the inadequate service.
