In accordance with the Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson on October 18, 2018, Pennsylvania Electric Company (“Penelec” or “Company”) submits this letter as a status report in the above-referenced matter. As of the date of this report, Penelec has issued discovery in this proceeding, as well as served its witness notification on January 4, 2019, the stated deadline for identification of witnesses. No such notice has been provided by the Complainant. Furthermore, despite an order issued by ALJ Watson on January 7, 2019, the Complainant still has not fully responded to all discovery propounded and directed in this matter, which was initially issued on October 30, 2018. To that end, the Company’s Motion to Dismiss, filed on February 13, 2019, remains pending.

To the extent that the Company’s Motion to Dismiss is held in abeyance or denied, the Company recommends that a prehearing conference be set to be held in this matter so as to address all outstanding issues before proceeding further in this matter.
