Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson on February 12, 2019, West Penn Power Company offers this letter as a status report in the above-referenced matter.

On January 23, 2019, West Penn initiated discovery in this proceeding in accordance with the procedural schedule set by Interim Order dated January 16, 2019 in this matter, which was revised on January 28, 2019. In light of the Complainant's representations that he was interested in pursuing a relocation of his meter rather than proceeding with this matter, West Penn provided a relocation quote. However, West Penn had requested that Mr. Hajduk provide some response as to his interest in moving forward with relocation of the meter by February 15, 2019. As of the date of this report, West Penn has not received a response. Further, given the Complainant's representations of his then-current medical condition, West Penn has, as a courtesy, declined to pursue responses to its Discovery Requests, to which neither objections nor responses have been served.

Given the lack of response to this point, the Company intends to move forward with a motion to compel response to be filed on April 1, 2019 to the extent the Complainant has not responded by that time. West Penn also suggests that it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine Mr. Hajduk's intent in moving his case forward.


