

REQUEST OF EXTENSION OF TIME FOR DISCOVERY



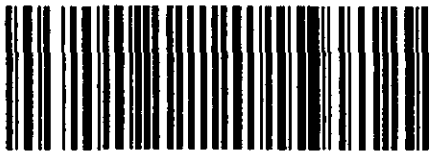
