Judge Watson:

I am in receipt of your offer to contract with me post marked 2-25-19 with a copy post marked 2-27-19. As of today, I am within my 3 Day Right of Recision. 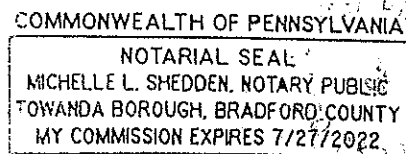

PREAMBLE, SCOPE AND TERMINOLOGY

APPLICATION

CANON 1

A judge shall uphold and promote the independence, integrity, and impartiality of the judiciary, and shall avoid impropriety and the appearance of impropriety.

CANON 2

A judge shall perform the duties of judicial office impartially, competently, and diligently.

CANON 3

A judge shall conduct the judge's personal and extrajudicial activities to minimize the risk of conflict with the obligations of judicial office.

CANON 4

A judge or candidate for judicial office shall not engage in political or campaign activity that is inconsistent with the independence, integrity, or impartiality of the judiciary.
