Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.103 Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) files this Joint Motion for a Continuance:

1. On or about October 19, 2018, Complainant filed two Formal Complaints at docket numbers C-2018-3005529 and C-2018-3005532 against Duquesne Light (collectively, “Complaints”) for two commercial accounts located on Cochran Road.
2. By Interim Order Scheduling Further Proceedings, dated January 31, 2019, the Honorable Administrative Law Judge (“ALJ”) Mary D. Long established a litigation schedule, including an in-person hearing date of March 19, 2019.
