Code § 62.101, a non-selling marketer is an individual or commercial entity, such as a telemarketing firm, door-to-door salesman or company, or auction-type website, **under contract to a single licensed NGS**, that provides marketing services to retail customers for natural gas supply services. 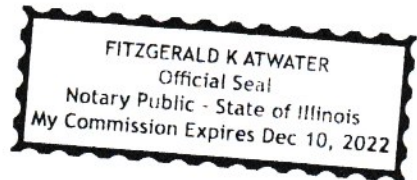



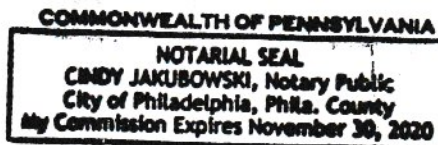
