I tried to contact the number on the letter (610) 921-6658 for Tori Giesler Esq

both mailboxes were full and I was unable to leave a message at 4:35pm

I would like to get clarification on the paperwork that was sent to me February 25, 2019.
I am not an attorney and I would like to have someone explain this to me layman's terms
I do not know what 52 Pa code 5.63,Act 129 and all other terms listed.

I did file a formal complaint with the utility commission and West Penn Power however, I want
to clarify **I did not "refuse" to have a smart meter installed that would result in my
electricity to be disconnected.** I had simply asked if there was any way I could opt out due to
health reasons. I felt hopeless and was asking for mercy.

If I am unable to opt -out I would like to request a 100% guarantee in writing that smart meters
do not cause any health issues. I understand you have statistics numbers comparing to WIFI,
Microwaves and cell phones. **Please note.** We don't sleep with our heads up against these
devices all night in our home. Our smart meter would be at the head of our bed as we are
sleeping.

If you could kindly contact me and explain what these means for me and what insufficient
information you are requesting to prove a case.

Once again, I do not want to have my service disconnected but would like a Guarantee from you
that smart meters will not pose a health risk for me or my husband. Our heads will be up against
it all night long we are unable to move the bed for it will block the doorway into the room or
closets.
