MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING DATE

PECO Energy Company ("PECO"), pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby request a continuance of the hearing date scheduled in this matter as follows:

1. An in-person hearing for this matter is currently scheduled to take place on Tuesday, March 26, 2019, at 10:00 AM.
2. The hearing was rescheduled from two previous hearing dates. The first hearing date scheduled was scheduled to take place on January 16, 2019. The Complainant, Christine Sharbaugh, requested a continuance of the hearing because she had travel plans to Atlanta, Georgia for a business event. PECO had no objection to Ms. Sharbaugh's continuance request. The second hearing date, February 20, 2019, the parties appeared at the hearing as scheduled; however, the hearing was continued due to a snow storm.
3. The Complainant alleges in her formal complaint that she sustained property damage arising from two power outages.
4. In defense of the case, PECO will present the testimony of Reliability Engineer, Madeline Devlin, who is the engineer assigned to Ms. Sharbaugh's circuit.
5. Ms. Devlin is unavailable for the March 26, 2019, hearing date as she has a previously scheduled field meeting and presentation with customers on the day of the rescheduled hearing.

6. The testimony of Ms. Devlin is critical to PECO's defense as she is the company's engineering specialist for the circuit at issue and she has technical knowledge of the Complainant's reliability claims.

7. PECO made two telephone calls to the Complainant to obtain her position on PECO's continuance request. PECO left a voicemail message for the first call and the company has not received a response. PECO attempted to reach the Complainant again and reached voicemail.

8. As PECO's key witnesses is not available for the March 26, 2019 hearing, PECO respectfully requests a continuance of this matter.

9. PECO Energy respectfully requests that the hearing be continued to a further date.
