1. The Applicant filed a limousine application concurrent with his paratransit application. The Applicant has already been approved for limousine authority and has procured insurance for such. The Applicant has met with his current insurance broker who informed him that he has a market for paratransit insurance as well that will meet his budgetary requirements
2. The Applicant has in excess of \$25,000.00 in vehicle assets. At the time of the application the owners had more than that in vehicles assets which are being leased to another company, but they were uncertain as to which vehicles would come over. Right now it is anticipated that three of the vehicles will be used in both paratransit and limousine service. One is newly purchased at van and the other two are sedans.
3. All of the assets belong to the company however a couple of the vehicles as stated above are currently being leased to another carrier. Upon the granting of the paratransit authority those vehicles will be available to Applicant but it is yet to be determined which ones as Applicant is currently reviewing the purchase of additional newer vehicles for paratransit that hold more passengers




