In accordance with the Interim Order issued by Administrative Law Judge Jeffrey A. Watson on November 30, 2018, Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed" or "Company") offers this letter as a status report in the above-referenced matter.

On January 16, 2019, Met-Ed initiated discovery in this proceeding in accordance with the procedural schedule set by Interim Order dated November 30, 2018 in this matter. As of the date of this report, Met-Ed has not received a response to those responses, and is awaiting the tolling of the deadline of April 9, 2019 to respond to these discovery requests as set by Interim Order Granting Met-Ed's Motion to Compel issued on March 13, 2019. Given the lack of response to this point, the Company intends to move forward with a motion to dismiss this matter by April 12, 2019 to the extent the Complainant has not responded by the April 4 deadline. Met-Ed also suggests that it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine the Complainant's intent in moving this matter forward.


