

PETITION OF RASIER-PA LLC

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

I. INTRODUCTION

By this Petition, Rasier-PA, LLC (“Rasier” or “Company”), pursuant to Section 4307(c.1) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code (“Vehicle Code”), 75 Pa.C.S. § 4307(c.1) and Section 5.41 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“PaPUC”) regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 5.41, hereby requests approval of an illuminated sign for use by Rasier transportation network service drivers in the course of providing transportation network service. In support of this request for approval, Rasier states the following.

II. DESCRIPTION OF RASIER-PA LLC

Rasier is a transportation network company (“TNC”) operating between points in Pennsylvania pursuant to a license granted by Order of the PaPUC on January 26, 2017 at Docket No. A-2016-2580821. The name and address of the Petitioner is:

III. REQUESTED APPROVAL

Section 4307(c.1) of the Vehicle Code states that “ a Transportation Network Company Driver may display an illuminated sign provided by a Transportation Network Company [TNC] within the interior of his or her vehicle so long as such sign is approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission or the Philadelphia Parking Authority , as applicable.” This Section of the Vehicle Code also states that “[t]he Transportation Network Company shall file the illuminated sign with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for review and approval.” 75 Pa.C.S. § 4307(c.1).

Rasier has attached as Exhibit 1 to this Petition an image of the illuminated sign (known as a Beacon) that it proposes to make available in the future to its drivers providing transportation network service in Pennsylvania. The illuminated sign’s dimensions are approximately 5 inches by 5 inches. Rasier submits that the illuminated sign depicted in Exhibit 1 is appropriate trade dress and requests PaPUC approval of this sign.


Rasier notes that pursuant to Section 4307(c.1), the PaPUC has fifteen (15) business days to complete its review of any illuminated sign filing. 75 Pa.C.S. § 4307(c.1).

IV. CONCLUSION

Wherefore, Rasier-PA LLC respectfully requests that the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission review and issue an approval of the illuminated sign depicted in Exhibit 1, within the fifteen (15) business days specified by the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.

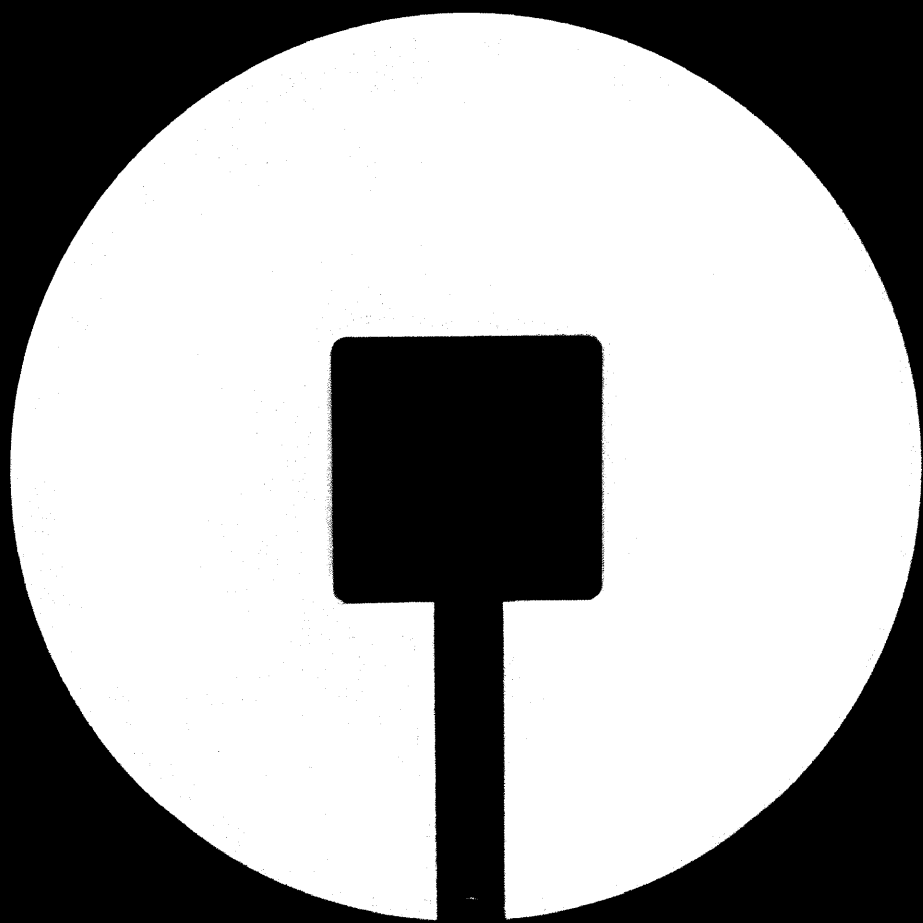


