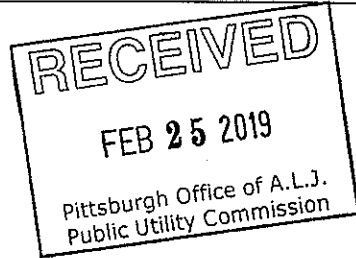

Dear Metropolitan Edison Co,
Dear PA Public Utility Commission Representa-
tives, re, Ann Hella Swartz, am advised that
I am a qualified individual with a medical
condition as defined by the Fair Housing
Amendments Act of 1988, the Americans with
Disabilities Act, and Section 504, Title 10,
as well as other related state and federal
discrimination laws. My residence is being
forced to accept an RF radiation meter that
does not meet safety standards required by
law and does not pass any Independent safety
tests - ex. UL confirms. I have been threatened
with loss of service by Metropolitan Edison Co
because of my medical condition - Anterior Uveitis
autoimmune disease, I request the following
accommodations - 1. continued use of my analog
meter - 2. I may "opt out" from installation of
"smart meter" without my ability, charging fees
or extra costs for the accommodation. Your
compliance with my request will enable me to have
an equal opportunity to live in, and enjoy my
home.

I am sending information concerning my
autoimmune disease, its diagnosis,
and treatment by Dr. Timothy Eskridge
& his records - Too, I am sending only a
small portion of world wide literature verifying
