TO ANSWER INTERROGATORY REQUEST SET 1 AND SET 2**



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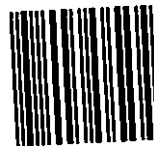

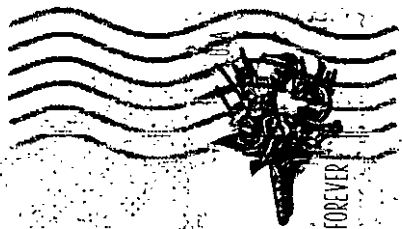
