**RESPONDENT'S STATUS REPORT**

Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") files this Status Report pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Interim Order dated March 14, 2019:

1. Duquesne Light has contacted their proposed fact and expert witnesses and identified their availability to present testimony at a hearing in this case on August 19-20, 2019. Complainant Francis Hriadil advised undersigned counsel that all of Complainants' proposed witnesses are also available on those dates.<sup>1</sup>

2. Given the nature of the case, Duquesne Light believes that all hearing witnesses should be required to testify in person rather than telephonically. However, if the Presiding ALJ permits telephonic testimony by Complainants' out-of-state witnesses (assuming they are even allowed to testify), then Duquesne Light requests an order stating that: (a) Complainants must testify in person; (b) Duquesne Light's employees must testify in person; and (c) Duquesne Light's out-of-state witnesses may testify telephonically.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>1</sup> This statement merely relates to scheduling and is not a concession by Duquesne Light that all of Complainants' proposed witnesses should be permitted to testify at the hearing, given the discovery violations highlighted in Duquesne Light's motions in limine. Duquesne Light will re-raise those arguments separately via motion in limine in accordance with the Presiding ALJ's prior orders.

<sup>2</sup> In which case, Duquesne Light would agree to identify which of its out-of-state witnesses would testify telephonically by written submission one week prior to the hearing date.


