Your Honor,

I am writing to you regarding Docket No. C-2019-3006923. I emailed Met Ed's attorneys on March 28, 2019 and on April 5, 2019 in addition to a follow up phone call where I left a voicemail requesting their decision to agree to a four month extension of the Litigation Schedule. As of the writing of this letter I have not heard from Met Ed's attorneys. I also received, by mail, Answer and New Matter of Met Ed and Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents (Set I) on Friday, April 5, 2019. I am unable to reply by the stated due dates for the following reasons and am appealing to you to include my responses to these documents to be due after the extension I am requesting.

Here is an abbreviated list of reasons for my request:

1. As a dyslexic person it takes me much longer to read through the vast amounts of text I need to in order to prepare and learn during this process. I have requested by email and phone call to the Met Ed attorneys to please email all documents but I am still receiving documents through the mail. To have the courtesy of receiving documents sent to my email allows me to send them to a family member to assist me.
2. I am developing a custom literacy curriculum for underprivileged students ranging from preschool through 7<sup>th</sup> grade. I will be using this curriculum as I volunteer for a summer camp that runs from June-July.
3. As a homeschooling mother, I have until June 30, 2019 to submit paperwork to the school district and I require extra time between now and June 30 to prepare and finish our school year.
4. I have two out-of-state trips with my daughter to tour colleges. She wanted to visit four schools, but because of the time commitment in preparing for this Formal Complaint process I have had to limit her to two choices only. I will be unable to work on this Formal Complaint process from April 19-25 as I will be travelling on one of these trips. This is another reason why I will not be able to respond to the two new documents mentioned above that I only received on April 5, 2019.

There are more reasons, but these are the main ones. I would greatly appreciate your understanding and your agreement to extend the Litigation Schedule and my responses to the two new documents that arrived to me on April 5, 2019 by four months.
