In accordance with the Interim Order issued on November 6, 2018, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). As of the date of this letter, West Penn has issued discovery (dated November 15, 2018), to which the Complainant has neither objected nor responded. To that end, West Penn filed a Motion to Compel on January 16, 2019, which remains pending at this time.

In addition, West Penn issued its witness notification to the presiding officer and the Complainant, as directed by the November 6, 2018 Interim Order. No such notification has been received from the Complainant.

At this point, West Penn recommends that a prehearing conference be set in this matter in order to ascertain the Complainant's intent in moving his case forward and, if so, to discuss revisions to the existing procedural schedule.
