





Under Paragraph 2.4.5 of the Rules Applicable to Distribution Service section of the Tariff of Columbia Gas, Sustainable Energy Services, Inc could be required to provide to Columbia Gas a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Columbia Gas determines to be appropriate. Sustainable Energy Services, Inc has indicated only brokering and consulting services will be provided. Therefore, we have determined at this time that Sustainable Energy Services, Inc does not need a bond or other financial security requirement to provide broker natural gas services to Columbia Gas customers.


