

RESPONDENT’S STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge’s Interim Order Granting in Part Complainant’s Request for an Extension of Time to the Established Litigation Schedule dated December 12, 2018 (“Amended Scheduling Order”), Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) submits this status report:

1. Discovery closed on March 20, 2019, and is complete.
2. In accordance with the Amended Scheduling Order, Duquesne Light provided Complainant with a copy of its witness list on February 1, 2019.
3. On February 1, 2019, Complainant served a document on Duquesne Light stating that he was attempting to identify witnesses but had been unable to do so thus far. Complainant has not supplemented this response since then, or identified any witnesses.
4. The last pending deadline in this matter is May 3, 2019, which sets the deadline for dispositive motions.
5. If Duquesne Light does not file a dispositive motion or if its motion is denied, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that any new scheduling order incorporate the following deadlines: (1) submission of exhibits and exhibit list approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date; and (2) submission of motions in limine approximately four weeks prior to the hearing.
