In accordance with the Revised Interim Order issued on January 30, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). As of the date of this letter, the parties have exchanged discovery, and discovery has concluded as of April 8, 2019. In addition, West Penn issued its witness notification to the presiding officer and the Complainant, as directed by the October 17, 2018 Interim Order. On January 9, 2019, the Complainant filed a Petition For Extension Of Time requesting an extension until March 11, 2019 to comply with the deadline originally scheduled for January 10, 2019. On January 30, 2019, a Revised Interim Order was issued providing the Complainant until February 19, 2019 to submit her witness notification. Despite that extension, no such notification has been received from the Complainant.

At this point, West Penn proposes that a prehearing conference be set to allow the parties to discuss amendments to the procedural schedule and to ascertain Ms. Sabatine's intent in producing witnesses in this matter.


