



### I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") grants licenses to CSD Energy Advisors LLC ("CSD Energy Advisors" or "Applicant") to function as an electricity and natural gas supplier in the District of Columbia.<sup>1</sup> The licenses for CSD Energy Advisors LLC are effective upon issuance of this Order.

### II. BACKGROUND

2. On April 23 and June 22, 2018, CSD Energy Advisors filed its license applications.<sup>2</sup> Specifically, CSD Energy Advisors indicates that it intends to operate as a broker of electricity pursuant to Section 34-1505 of the "Retail Electric Competition and Consumer Protection Act of 1999" ("Act")<sup>3</sup> and as a broker of natural gas pursuant to the Commission's licensing requirements as set forth in GT 96-3, Order Nos. 12709 and 12903.<sup>4</sup> In both filings, the Applicant represents that it intends to serve commercial and

industrial customers in the District of Columbia. CSD Energy Advisors provided the following information in compliance with the Commission's licensing requirements:<sup>5</sup>

- c) Proof of financial integrity to include financial statements;
- d) Proof that CSD Energy Advisors has registered with the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to do business in the District of Columbia;
- e) Affidavits certifying that CSD Energy Advisors is subject to all applicable taxes;
- f) Affidavits certifying that CSD Energy Advisors will comply with all the requirements of all orders and regulations of the Commission; and

CSD Energy Advisors filed supplemental information on June 19 and July 19, 2018.<sup>6</sup>

### III. <u>DISCUSSION</u>

3. Our review of the information contained in CSD Energy Advisors' applications, demonstrate that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and the financial integrity to serve electricity and natural gas customers in the District of Columbia. The Commission also finds that granting CSD Energy Advisors' applications will serve the public interest by fostering competition in the District's energy market. Accordingly, CSD Energy Advisors' applications are approved.

Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000. Staff recommended that CSD Energy's registration application be approved for a two-year term.

Your application for registration is approved effective as of October 25, 2018, under Puc 2003.05(g)(1). The registration is for a term of two years and expires at the close of business on October 25, 2020. Pursuant to Puc 2003.06(a), you must submit your renewal application at least 60 days prior to the expiration of the approved registration term, on or before August 26, 2020.

Please be aware that registered providers of electric aggregation service are subject to specific requirements contained in N.H. Code Admin. Rules Puc 2000 – Competitive Electric Power Supplier and Aggregator Rules. These rules are available at: http://www.puc.nh.gov/Regulatory/Rules/PUC2000.pdf.

Please note that, effective as of July 1, 2014, each registered electric load aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July 1 through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.

ORDER GRANTING LICENSE

VANNOY, Chairman; WILLIAMSON and DAVIS, Commissioners

### I. SUMMARY

Through this Order, CSD Energy Advisors, LLC (CSD or the Company) is issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider furnishing aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine's service territories pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

### II. APPLICATION AND DECISION

On May 2, 2018, CSD applied to the Commission to operate in Maine as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305. The Company proposes to provide aggregator/broker service to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine's service territories and has met all the Chapter 305 filing requirements.

As a licensed competitive electricity provider, CSD is required to comply with all applicable requirements and regulations, including all conditions of licensing, assignments, customer protection rules, and the filing of annual reports. To the extent that a licensed competitive electricity provider uses third-parties to assist in obtaining customers during the course of its business, Chapter 305 § 4(C) of the Commission's rules places the responsibility on the competitive electricity provider for violations of the provisions of this section by representatives or agents acting on the competitive electricity provider's behalf. Chapter 305 § 2(C)(3) also requires a competitive electricity provider to use reasonable efforts to avoid conducting business with any entity acting as a competitive electricity provider in Maine without a license from the Commission. Therefore, if the Company uses a third party to market its services, it is responsible to ensure that the third party has met any licensing requirements of the Commission.

Pursuant to a Delegation Order dated April 23, 2008 in Docket No. 2008-185, PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, Delegation of Authority to License Competitive Electricity Providers, the Commission delegated to the Director of Technical Analysis the authority under 35-A M.R.S. §§ 3203 (1) & (2) and Chapter 305, §2 to license competitive electricity providers. The Commission no longer has a Director of Technical Analysis and all existing delegation orders that delegate Commission authority to the Director of Technical Analysis is now delegated to the Director of Electric and Gas Utility Industries.

Accordingly, it is

### ORDERED

- That CSD Energy Advisors, LLC is hereby issued a license to operate as a competitive electricity provider pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules, to provide aggregator/broker services to the non-residential customer classes throughout Maine's service territories pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules; and
- 2. That this license is effective on the date of this Order and valid until revoked or suspended by the Commission pursuant to section 3(A)(4) of Chapter 305, or abandoned by the licensee pursuant to sections 2(D)(10) and 2(D)(11) of Chapter 305 of the Commission's Rules.

### NOTICE OF RIGHTS TO REVIEW OR APPEAL

5 M.R.S. § 9061 requires the Public Utilities Commission to give each party to an adjudicatory proceeding written notice of the party's rights to review or appeal of its decision made at the conclusion of the adjudicatory proceeding. The methods of review or appeal of PUC decisions at the conclusion of an adjudicatory proceeding are as follows:

- 1. Reconsideration of the Commission's Order may be requested under Section 1004 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (65-407 C.M.R.110) within 20 days of the date of the Order by filing a petition with the Commission stating the grounds upon which reconsideration is sought. Any petition not granted within 20 days from the date of filing is denied.
- 2. <u>Appeal of a final decision</u> of the Commission may be taken to the Law Court by filing, within 21 days of the date of the Order, a Notice of Appeal with the Administrative Director of the Commission, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. § 1320(1)-(4) and the Maine Rules of Appellate Procedure.
- 3. Additional court review of constitutional issues or issues involving the justness or reasonableness of rates may be had by the filing of an appeal with the Law Court, pursuant to 35-A M.R.S. § 1320(5).

<u>Note</u>: The attachment of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the particular document may be subject to review or appeal. Similarly, the failure of the Commission to attach a copy of this Notice to a document does not indicate the Commission's view that the document is not subject to review or appeal.


