Please note that each registered natural gas aggregator is subject to an annual assessment of \$2,000, unless it demonstrates that its gross revenue in New Hampshire during the preceding fiscal year (from July I through June 30) was less than \$10,000, pursuant to RSA 363-A:2, III and 5.



Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that Ski Brokerage does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by Ski Brokerage the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to Ski Brokerage changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require Ski Brokerage to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.


