

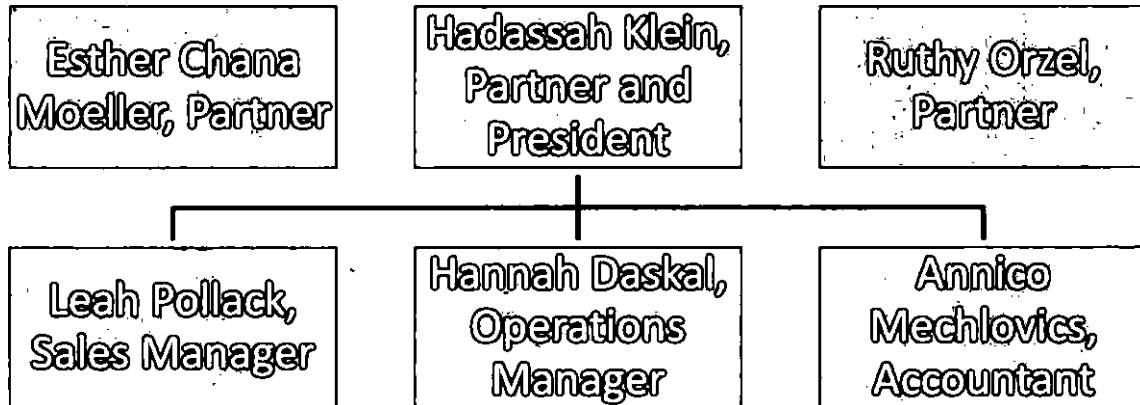

As you know, in making such an application, Service King International Brokers LLC dba SKI Brokerage must furnish acceptable security to each utility where Service King International Brokers LLC dba SKI Brokerage will do business. 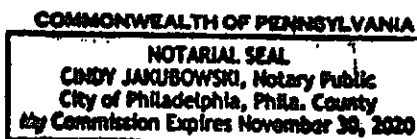

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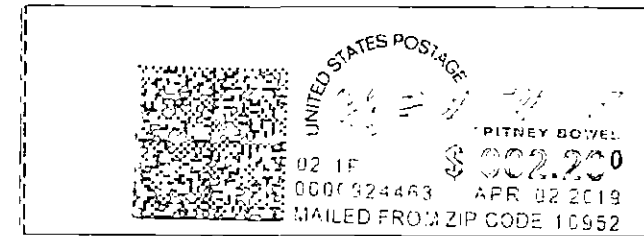
