PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or “Company”) submits the following written response pursuant to the directive set forth in the Commission’s Secretarial Letter dated March 26, 2019, at Docket No. M-2018-3006032 outlining the process it will follow to provide institutional regulatory commitment knowledge continuity regarding Commission regulations and commitments. The Company expects to complete this process by year-end.

1. PPL Electric will conduct a review of the Commission’s regulations and orders to identify the communication, notification, and filing requirements applicable to PPL Electric.
2. PPL Electric will conduct an internal canvass to identify how such regulatory commitments and filing requirements from Step 1 are referenced or documented. Each department will be asked to:
 - a. identify all required filings, reports, communications and notices it provides to the Commission; and
 - b. show evidence of relevant references or documentation with regard to such filings.

3. PPL Electric will then reconcile the results of the review of Commission regulations and orders in Step 1 to the results of its internal canvass in Step 2.
 - a. Any identified gaps will be reviewed with the appropriate department for documentation.
4. The Company will develop a matrix to track the identified regulatory requirements, how compliance with such requirements is documented, and the responsible Company departments or personnel.
 - a. On a periodic basis, such matrix will be reviewed, revised (if necessary), and redistributed to responsible departments for compliance with the identified regulatory requirements and commitments.

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §1.11, the enclosed document is to be deemed filed on April 25, 2019, which is the date it was filed electronically using the Commission's E-Filing System.
