Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on October 15, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("West Penn"). In accordance with that Interim Order, West Penn initiated discovery on September 14, 2018. However, the Complainants have yet to respond to West Penn's discovery, despite the presiding officer issuing an order granting West Penn's motion to compel that discovery on November 28, 2018, setting a deadline of December 14, 2018 to comply. Not only did this afford them extra time to respond, an extension request was granted on January 4, 2019, giving the Complainants until January 17, 2019 to respond. Most recently, the Complainants requested yet another extension, until February 27, 2019 to respond. Out of courtesy, West Penn intentionally waited until that time to permit the Complainants to respond. Further, the Complainants have failed to provide notification of their expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the October 15, 2018 Interim Order. To that end, West Penn filed a Motion to Dismiss this matter on March 6, 2019. That motion remains outstanding at this time.

As such, West Penn suggests that the setting of a prehearing conference in this matter would be of value to determine the Complainants' interest in pursuing this matter further and, if so, to address various procedural matters in preparation for evidentiary hearings.


