GOVERNING THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS
IN PARATRANSIT SERVICE, BETWEEN POINTS IN PENNSYLVANIA**

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in paratransit service, from points in Bethlehem Township, Northampton County and within an airline distance of 90 statutory miles of the municipality (excluding points of origin in Bucks, Chester, Montgomery, Northumberland and Schuylkill Counties) to points in Pennsylvania and return.

LIST OF CHANGES MADE BY THIS TARIFF

1. Changed the pricing structure of the base rate to a two-tiered pricing structure, with one rate for the transportation of persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables based on medical recommendation (this rate is unchanged from the previous tariff) and a second rate for all other transports (this rate is lower than the rate for the transportation of persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables).
2. Changed the pricing structure of the mileage rate to a two-tiered pricing structure, with one rate for the transportation of persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables based on medical recommendation (this rate is unchanged from the previous tariff) and a second rate for all other transports (this rate is lower than the rate for the transportation of persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables).
3. Added a wait time charge for transports not involving persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADVANCE NOTICE

Advanced reservations must be made at least one hour prior to when service is to be rendered.

NON-EXCLUSIVITY OF SERVICE

Service is provided on a non-exclusive basis.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

Any and all additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of either the passenger or the party making the reservation (such as, but not limited to, tolls, parking fees, entrance fees, and other out of pocket expenses) shall be added to the charge for the trip.

MILEAGE RATE

Mileage hereunder shall be governed by the actual odometer reading of the vehicle(s) for all loaded miles or fraction thereof on which the customer is on board the vehicle from the requested point of pickup to the requested point of drop off.

CONTRACT SERVICES

Contract services will be for a term of not less than 30 days for prequalified persons under a federal, state, county or municipal governmental agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts, copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

SCHEDULE OF RATES
(per person)

1. **Base Rates** – for all loaded-mile trips from the point of pickup to the point of destination.

(C) • For all persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables (based on medical recommendation) - \$180.00 per one-way trip

(C)(R) • For all other paratransit transports - \$49.00 per one-way trip

2. **Mileage Rates** – apply in addition to the Base Rates stated above on all loaded miles or fraction thereof from the point of pickup to the point of destination.

(C) • For all persons seeking mental health treatment and requiring the use of duly-elected Pennsylvania State Constables (based on medical recommendation) - \$3.25 per loaded mile or fraction thereof

(C)(R) • For all other paratransit transports - \$4.50 per loaded mile or fraction thereof

3. **Extra Attendant Charge** - applies in addition to the Base Rates stated above whenever a second attendant is needed, at either the request of the passenger or the party making the reservation.

(C) 4. **Wait Time Charge** – Apply in addition to the base rate for transports not involving persons seeking mental health treatment, where applicable

(C) • \$25/hour or fraction thereof after the first half hour

(A) indicates an increase in rates

(C) indicates a change or addition

(R) indicates a decrease in rates
