Today I spoke with Eva at the PUC and was transferred to Gail in your legal department regarding my request for more time to complete the discovery process.



Honorable Jeffrey A. Watson:


On March 20, 2019 I sent you a Motion For Extension Of Date For Completing Discovery, requesting 60 days. You in turn extended my time for a period of 30 days until April 29, 2019.

I have been trying to meet your deadline but due to sever and debilitating chronic pain I will not be able to meet this deadline. I do have an appointment with my doctor but could not be seen before April 29, 2019. This is an ongoing issue that has been addressed by several doctors and many tests. 
Due to health issues and severe and debilitating pain I am requesting additional time to conclude discovery in order to prepare my case properly.


