Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

On April 15, 2019 Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light" or the "Company") sent by overnight mailing the Letter of Notification of Duquesne Light Company, filed pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57 Subchapter G, for approval to install a new 138 kV line and reconductor existing circuits to support the Southeast Capacity Project located in the Borough of Dravosburg, Borough of West Mifflin, Borough of Jefferson Hills, Union Township, and Forward Township in Allegheny and Washington Counties, Pennsylvania ("Southeast Capacity Project LON"). At the time of filing, Duquesne Light indicated Attachments 1, 2 and 6 were marked confidential.

Commission staff requested Duquesne Light clarify whether the confidential attachments also contain Confidential Security Information, or "CSI." Upon review, Attachments 1, 2, and 6 contain CSI as that term is defined by 52 Pa. Code § 102.1, and Duquesne Light respectfully requests the Commission treat Attachments 1, 2, and 6 as confidential and CSI-classified documents.


