RESPONDENT'S STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Order Establishing Initial Litigation Schedule dated December 14, 2018 ("Scheduling Order"), Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") submits this status report:

1. As required by the Scheduling Order, Duquesne Light provided Complainant with a copy of its witness list on February 1, 2019.
2. Complainant has not provided Duquesne Light with a witness list.
3. Duquesne Light served its First Set of Discovery Requests Directed to Complainant on October 25, 2018. In a letter dated November 13, 2018, Complainant stated he would not provide discovery responses.
4. Duquesne Light filed a Motion to Compel on November 20, 2018, which was granted. Complainant provided partial discovery responses on January 2, 2019. Duquesne Light filed another Motion to Compel on March 26, 2019, seeking complete responses.
5. In an Interim Order dated April 3, 2019, the Presiding Administrative Law Judge granted Duquesne Light's second Motion to Compel. Complainant was ordered to provide complete responses to Duquesne Light's discovery requests. Alternatively, if Complainant determined that he did not wish to testify at the evidentiary hearing, the Interim Order instructed

the parties to enter into a stipulation in lieu of providing complete discovery responses. The parties were ordered to file the stipulation by April 12, 2019.

6. In a Response to Interim Order to Compel dated April 8, 2019, Complainant stated that "it is not necessary for me to testify at the evidentiary hearing" and that "any information being requested about me personally, and about what is contained in my home is irrelevant and inapplicable." He did not provide any additional discovery responses.

7. The next day, Duquesne Light sent a Joint Stipulation to Complainant (as required by the Interim Order dated April 3, 2019). A copy of the Joint Stipulation is attached as Exhibit A.

8. Complainant did not sign the Joint Stipulation, or otherwise respond to Duquesne Light, by April 12, 2019 (the deadline for submitting the Joint Stipulation to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge).

9. No other deadlines are pending at this time.

10. If Duquesne Light does not file a dispositive motion or if its motion is denied, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that any new scheduling order incorporate the following deadlines: (1) submission of exhibits and exhibit list approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date; and (2) submission of motions in limine approximately four weeks prior to the hearing.


