In response to the Amended Application of Sherpa Fiber LLC (“Applicant”) in the above-docketed proceeding, upon review of the proposed Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (“CLEC”) tariff, the Applicant received a list of corrections/modifications from the Telco Section of the Bureau of Technical Utility Services that were required for compliance of the proposed CLEC tariff.

Accordingly, the attached proposed CLEC Business Tariff of Sherpa Fiber LLC has been revised as follows:

- The CLEC Tariff Number has been changed to No. 2;
- The title page has been identified as “Title Page” on the Check Sheet, making the total numbered pages listed on the check sheet 86;
- The following Definitions have been deleted: – “Customer Designated Premises,” “Dedicated Access,” “MSAG Formatting, Format,” “Resold Local Exchange Service,” “Telephone Company System,” and “Transmission Path;”
- Pages 49, 52, and 59 – Formatting issues have been corrected;
- Page 25, Section 2.5.1 – Payment for Service – The following sentence has been added: “If bills are paid by mail, the date of the postmark will be considered the date of payment;” and
- Page 61 – Section 3.3.3 – The words “Customer Premise Equipment” have been deleted since the Commission does not regulate this.
