PUBLIC STATEMENT OF THE
OFFICE OF CONSUMER ADVOCATE
PURSUANT TO 71 P.S. SECTION 309-4(e)

Act 161 of the Pennsylvania General Assembly, 71 P.S. Section 309-2, as enacted July 9, 1976, authorizes the Consumer Advocate to represent the interests of consumers before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). In accordance with Act 161, and for the following reasons, the Acting Consumer Advocate determined to file an Intervention and participate in proceedings before the Commission involving Philadelphia Gas Works' (PGW) Supplement No. 120 to its Gas Service Tariff – Pa P.U.C. No. 2 (Gas Supplement No. 120) filing at Docket No. R-2019-3009016.

On April 5, 2019, PGW filed Gas Supplement No. 120 with the Commission in order to obtain approval of its Negotiable Liquefied Natural Gas Tariff (Rate LNG-N) with an effective date of June 4, 2019. Proposed Gas Supplement No. 120 would replace Rate LNG with Rate LNG-N and permit PGW to charge rates so that third parties can utilize PGW's facilities to transport, liquefy, inject, store, vaporize, withdraw, and deliver their own natural gas for sale through Rate LNG-N.

The OCA has determined to intervene and participate in these proceedings to ensure that the Application is approved only if it meets all legal requirements of the Public Utility Code, applicable Commission rules and regulations, and Pennsylvania law, as well as to ensure that the interest of PGW's ratepayers are protected in this proceeding.
