MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.103 and 52 Pa. Code §1.15, Respondent Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light”) files this Motion for a Continuance:

1. On February 28, 2019 Complainant filed a Formal Complaint against Duquesne Light regarding her residential account for electric service located at 1309 Wesley Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15221.
2. By Prehearing Order, dated May 1, 2019, a telephonic hearing for the above-captioned matter was scheduled for May 21, 2019.
3. The undersigned attorney and the fact witness representing Duquesne Light in the above-referenced proceeding will be on vacation on May 21, 2019.
4. The Prehearing Order stated, “[a] request for a change of the scheduled hearing date must state the agreement or opposition of the other parties and must be submitted in writing no later than five days prior to the hearing” (emphasis in original).
