Your Honor,

Thank you for the opportunity to reschedule and be represented by an attorney. I have tried to reach the attorney I had planned to hire; however, I have been unable to reach him. He was out last week; therefore, he may be very busy this week and unable to get back to me as quickly as you requested.

I should have asked a question yesterday but did not think of it. I would like to know why, in the case of someone with a documented disability, and declining health, why a litigation schedule must be adhered to? Act 129 does not mandate smart meters for a few years, I already have one, and I am trying to withdraw my formal complaint for health and disability reasons. Yesterday I was feeling well because I was out of my house for two days, in a place where I usually feel much better. Today I am exhausted and not feeling well, unable to do as much. I wanted to write early because I may not feel well enough later to do so, and the deadline is 4pm today. My disability limits what I can do, when my disabling health conditions are not well controlled. I am in the process of obtaining additional documentation of this from my physician, as an act of good faith in light of my request for additional time to reach my attorney and have my formal complaint withdrawn without prejudice. I need an ADA accommodation of additional time, because I do not feel comfortable proceeding with the telephone conference without one, in part because of my lack of knowledge of legal matters and in part because of my disability.

I will forward you a letter from my physician as soon as I obtain it. Thank you again for the opportunity to reschedule this telephone conference.
