## JOINT MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS FOR 60 DAYS

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code. § 5.103, Complainant, Daniel Eaby ("Complainant"), and Respondent, Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light"), file this Joint Motion to Stay Proceedings for 60 Days ("Joint Motion"). Complainant and Duquesne Light jointly shall be called "the Parties" in this Joint Motion.

1. On October 1, 2018, Complainant filed a Formal Complaint against Duquesne Light to prevent it from installing a smart meter(s) at his property located at 5417 Butler Street, Pittsburgh, PA 15201 ("the Property").

2. Duquesne Light filed an Answer on October 22, 2018.

3. The pleadings are closed.

4. The Parties are working together to try to settle this case, and wish to continue their settlement discussions without incurring additional litigation costs and burdens.

5. The Parties thus respectfully request that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge suspend all pending activity and deadlines in this case for 60 days from the date this Joint Motion is filed, and that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge issue no new scheduling orders or deadlines during this 60-day period.

7. If the Parties do not settle the case within 60 days from date the Joint Motion is filed, they shall submit a Joint Status Report to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge that sets forth the status of the case and that proposes new litigation deadlines.

WHEREFORE, Complainant, Daniel Eaby, and Respondent, Duquesne Light Company, respectfully request that all activity and deadlines in this case be stayed for 60 days from the date this Joint Motion is filed, and that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge issue no new scheduling orders or deadlines during this 60-day time period.


