Dear Honorable Jeffrey Watson and Rosemary Chiavetta:

Just following up on my prior correspondence dated 2/13/19 and 4/17/19 requesting withdrawal of my case/Complaint. Please withdraw my case/complaint if it has not already been done.


For some unknown reason, after I have withdrawn my case/complaint I received in the mail today correspondence from First Energy dated May 9, 2019 again requesting answers to their Interrogatories and Requests for Production of Documents and Motion. The Notice To Plead states I have five (5) days to respond. However, I just received the above documents today which gives me less than 8 hours to respond not five days (see First Energy envelope attached dated May 9, 2019 which is proof of the date they mailed it. It takes 5 to 7 days for standard mail to be delivered. First Energy did not take into consideration the standard time for the letter to be delivered to me. First Energy repeatedly does this in order to keep me from replying back in a timely manner. It is impossible for me to respond so quickly. Please allow an extension of time – for one I have withdrawn my case/complaint a long time ago and I don't know why I am receiving the above documents. I need to find out if my case/complaint has been withdrawn which I requested on (2/13/19 and 4/17/19). Second, if it has been withdrawn then there are no documents to be file. "I do not know the status of my case at the present time -- whether it is withdrawn or not". Please let me know as soon as possible the status.

In addition, I was told my case/complaint is considered withdrawn by your office and I was sent a cancellation notice in the mail. If my case has not been withdrawn, please withdraw my case/complaint.

Moreover, First Energy knows that I have withdrawn my complaint and they know this from my correspondence to them -- So why would First Energy send the attached documents to me again when I have withdrawn? This is madness. "I cannot go any further without an attorney to which non is available"

I wish my case to be ruled as withdrawn because I cannot find an attorney to represent me at this time. In addition, I do not feel comfortable representing myself. This is not a simple process – and I am not a lawyer and do not know how to proceed with the documents. As a result my case should be considered withdrawn and not dismissed.

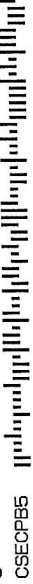
