**RESPONDENT'S STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to the Presiding Administrative Law Judge's Order Interim Order Establishing Litigation Schedule dated January 2, 2019 ("Scheduling Order"), Respondent Duquesne Light Company ("Duquesne Light") submits this status report:

1. As required by the Scheduling Order, Duquesne Light served Complainant with a copy of its list of potential witnesses on February 28, 2019.
2. Duquesne Light has not received a list of potential witnesses from Complainant.
3. Under the Scheduling Order, discovery closed on April 5, 2019. Duquesne Light served its First Set of Discovery Requests Directed to Complainant on February 8, 2019. Complainant provided partial discovery responses on or about March 7, 2019. He provided supplemental responses on or about March 28, 2019, but still failed to answer every discovery request in full. On April 9, 2019, Duquesne Light filed a Motion to Compel Discovery Responses. Complainant filed a timely response in opposition. Duquesne Light filed a reply brief. The Presiding Administrative Law Judge has not yet ruled on Duquesne Light's Motion to Compel Discovery Responses.
4. No other deadlines are pending at this time.

5. If Duquesne Light does not file a dispositive motion or if its motion is denied, Duquesne Light respectfully requests that any new scheduling order incorporate the following deadlines: (1) submission of exhibits and exhibit list approximately six weeks prior to the hearing date; and (2) submission of motions in limine approximately four weeks prior to the hearing.
