SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - GOVERNING PUBLICATIONS

Shipments moving 40 miles and under - Governed, except as otherwise provided herein by Freight Pa. P. U. C. #1 issued by this carrier, supplements thereto and reissues thereof.

ITEM 20 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound, per article. For method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound, per article, see Governing Tariff.

ITEM 30 - TOLLS

▲ Any tolls incurred during the course of the move will be billed back to the customer. Please keep in mind that tolls for commercial vehicles are often more expensive than tolls for passenger vehicles.

ITEM 40 - PARKING TICKETS

Any parking tickets incurred during the course of a move will be billed back to customer.

ITEM 50 - GOVERNING PUBLICATION

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight PA. P.U.C. No. 53 9Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive reissues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 200 - PIANO FEE

▲ There will be an additional one-hundred, fifty (\$150.00) dollars fee assessed for moving a piano during the course of any move. Only upright pianos are moved and they are moved from the first (1st) floor of one location to the first (1st) floor of another location.

ITEM 220 - ADDITIONAL LABOR

Carrier may provide, at the request of the shipper, additional labor to the job. Each additional laborer will increase the hourly rate by forty (\$40.00) dollars.

ITEM 230 - ADDITIONAL TRUCKS

If the shipper's property to be moved is deemed too large to fit on one truck, carrier may use an additional truck. There is a fee of one-hundred, fifty (\$150.00) dollars for each additional truck.

ITEM 240 - OVERNIGHT CHARGE

In the event the customer needs to store his/her goods overnight on any of the carrier's trucks, a fee of one-hundred, fifty (\$150.00) dollars will be imposed per truck per night.

SECTION 2
ADDITIONAL SERVICE CHARGES

ITEM 260 - PACKING, UNPACKING AND CONTAINER CHARGES

Packing services are offered whether or not customer chooses to use carrier's moving services. All pack jobs are subject to a three (3) hours minimum charge. The hourly rate for pack jobs is the same as hourly moving rates shown in Section 3 (Item 300). Additional charges, such as, fuel surcharge and tolls will still apply, if applicable.

NOTE 1 - Every move is subject to a three (3) hours minimum.

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 are based on the day or days, or period of days, as indicated during which services are performed and the method of payment.

NOTE 3 - Deposits/Refunds: A deposit of \$50.00 is required by the carrier to reserve a specific move date. The deposit will be applied to reduce the final moving charge. The deposit will be refunded if the shipper cancels the move 24 hours or more in advance of the scheduled move date. If shipper gives carrier less than 24 hours notice of cancellation, the deposit will not be refunded.

NOTE 4 - Credit cards will be accepted by the carrier for payment of moving charges (refer to rates in Columns 3 and 4).

NOTE 5 - When treadmills and/r safes are part of the shipment, the following charges will be assessed for each treadmill and/or safe in the shipment in addition to the hourly rates shown above: 1) - TREADMILLS - \$100.00 2) - SAFES - \$100.00
