Thank you for your letter of March 28, 2000.

Your letter indicates that you represent Unitil Resources, Inc., d/b/a Usource ("Usource"), a New Hampshire corporation authorized to do business within the State of Pennsylvania. You indicate further that Usource has made application for a license from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission ("PUC") to do business as a electricity broker in Pennsylvania.

As a broker, Usource will represent various out-of-state sellers of electricity and natural gas. Through the use of its internet "platform," Pennsylvania purchasers and those nonresident sellers represented by Usource, may enter into agreements for the purchase of electricity or natural gas. Usource does not take title to the natural gas or electricity. Usource simply provides the "platform" through which sellers and purchasers may enter into agreements. Usource receives a commission from the energy suppliers for each agreement.

You indicate that the license application required be filed by Usource with the PUC requires the applicant provide its sales tax license number. You seek our opinion as to whether or not Usource is required to hold a Pennsylvania sales tax license under the facts set forth above. John J. Gallagher, Esq. April 12, 2000 Page Two

The provisions of Section 208 of the Tax Reform Code (72 P.S. \$7208) provide that every person maintain a place of business in the Commonwealth selling or leasing services or tangible personal property, the sale of which is subject to tax, is required to make application to the Department for a sales and use tax license. If the person, does not maintain a place of business or does not sell or lease taxable tangible personal property or taxable services, a person is not required to hold a Pennsylvania sales tax license.

Notwithstanding the fact that the application required to be submitted by Usource to the PUC requires the insertion of a Pennsylvania sales and use tax license number, based upon the facts that you have provided to us, Usource is not required to hold a Pennsylvania sales and use tax license number.

The nonresident sellers which your company represents that make taxable sales of electricity and natural gas within the State of Pennsylvania are required to hold a Pennsylvania sales and use tax license number. These companies are also required to collect and remit to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue the applicable sales or use tax due and owing on the taxable sales of electricity and natural gas they make to Pennsylvania residents. We acknowledge receipt of the Affidavit executed by Lawrence M. Brock, Controller of Unitel Resources, attesting that all of the sellers represented by Usource are licensed with the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue for the collection of sales and use tax.







COMMENT FOLDE

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Unitil Resources Inc expires on 3/9/2003.

RE License Bond or Other Financial Security

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.

Dear Mr. Stewart:

Pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. §2809(c), no electric supplier license shall remain in force unless the licensee furnishes a bond or other security approved by the Commission to ensure the financial responsibility of the electric generation supplier and the supply of electricity at retail. The Commission's records indicate that the bond or other approved security provided by Unitil Resources Inc expires on March 9, 2007.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.40(d) require "the security level for each licensee will be reviewed annually and modified primarily based upon the licensee's reported annual gross receipts information. The security level will be 10% of the licensee's reported gross receipts." The minimum security level provided may not be less than the initial security level provided when the license was granted. Unless approved by the Commission, the initial security level is \$250,000.

The Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code §54.39(b) require a licensee to file an annual report on or before April 30 of each year, for the previous calendar year, in order to comply with 66 Pa. C.S. §2810(c)(6). This report discloses the total amount of gross receipts from the sale of electricity and the total amount of electricity sold during the preceding calendar year. You must use this same information in calculating the appropriate security level necessary to maintain your license.

In order for your company to maintain its status as a licensed electric supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, it must provide proof to the Commission that a bond or other approved security has been obtained.

Your response in this matter is requested within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Submit your response to the Commission's Secretary. Additionally, fax a copy of your response to James Shurskis at (717) 787-4750, Bureau of Fixed Utility Services.

Failure to respond to this matter within fifteen (15) days will cause Commission staff to initiate a formal proceeding, that may lead to the following: cancellation of your company's electric supplier license, removal of your information from the Commission's website and notification to all electric distribution companies, in which your company is licensed to do business, of the cancellation of the license.
