

Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on November 9, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Consistent with that Interim Order, Met-Ed initiated discovery on November 15, 2018. Ms. Spohn did not respond to Met-Ed's discovery. To that end, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Compel on January 31, 2019. An Interim Order was issued granting the motion and ordering Ms. Spohn to provide full and complete responses by March 1, 2019. Again, no response was received from Ms. Spohn and, on April 4, 2019, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Dismiss. That motion remains outstanding at this time. Further, Ms. Spohn has failed to provide notification of her expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the November 9, 2018 Interim Order. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses. Met-Ed suggests that it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine Ms. Spohn's intent in moving her complaint forward.
