Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order Revising Litigation Schedule issued on May 23, 2019 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of West Penn Power Company ("Company"). First, the Company notes that it will be submitting, contemporaneously with this status report, a revised witness notification in which the Company notes that it anticipates presenting only two witnesses, Mr. John Ahr and Mr. Scott Palmquist.

Separately, the Company has had the opportunity to discuss witnesses and hearing dates with Mr. Adams. It is the Company's understanding that Mr. Adams has proposed in his own status report (issued before the parties connected) the following dates for hearings: August 27-29, September 3-5, and September 24-25, 2019. The Company and its witnesses are unavailable on the last of those dates, but is available on August 27-29, as well as September 3-5, 2019. It is the Company's belief that due to the fact that there are expected to be a total of four witnesses presenting testimony in this proceeding, one day of evidentiary hearings will be sufficient.

The Company requests that the hearing be held in person for purposes of the Company's counsel and the Complainant, given the logistics involved in the volume of material expected to be presented. However, the Company requests that for both parties, witnesses be permitted to testify telephonically.


