Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 27, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Consistent with that Interim Order, Met-Ed initiated discovery on February 4, 2019. Ms. McDonald did not respond to Met-Ed's discovery. Rather, the Complainant submitted letters on February 19, 2019, April 17, 2019, and again on May 14, 2019 requesting to withdraw her Formal Complaint. Further, Ms. McDonald has failed to provide notification of her expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the December 27, 2018 Interim Order. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses.

Due to Ms. McDonald's lack of response to discovery and other procedural deadlines, as well as her multiple requests to withdraw the Formal Complaint, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Dismiss on May 9, 2019. The Motion remains pending.

A prehearing conference was scheduled to be held on April 26, 2019, but a cancellation notice was issued on March 20, 2019, cancelling that prehearing. At this point, Met-Ed believes that a ruling on its Motion and/or Ms. McDonald's request to withdraw is appropriate. In the alternative, it may be helpful to reschedule a prehearing conference in this matter in order to discuss these outstanding filings.
