
Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

I am writing to you in my capacity as legal counsel to Stream Energy Pennsylvania, LLC ("Stream Energy"). On May 6, 2019, Stream Energy filed an Annual Compliance Filing to maintain its reduced bonding level of 5%. Stream Energy received your May 10, 2019 correspondence requesting that it supplement its filing with a Tax Status Letter of Good Standing from the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue ("Department") by June 10, 2019. The purpose of this letter is to request an additional 15 days (until June 25, 2019) to submit the Tax Status Letter.
