

5. West Penn Power's Status Report is too brief to merit the discussion you anticipate. WPP has my status report, and has not commented on it, nor have you. What precisely do you expect to transpire regarding discussion of the status reports? I like to be prepared.

6. What are the "outstanding matters" to which you refer? I wish to be informed of these in advance so I can give them some thought.

C. On page 2, paragraph 3 you refer to my filing a response to your Interim Order denying Motion to Compel, which letter you received on May 20, 2019. My letter raised the possibility that you had not in hand my letter of April 18, Response to Answer of WPP to our Motion to Compel. On June 3, I confirmed with Janette that you had not received this letter, and sent my letter dated June 3 enclosing this April 18 letter, with the request that you revisit my Motion to Compel and reconsider your decision with my letter of April 18 in hand. Since the date of your present letter of May 30 precedes your having in hand my April 18 letter, your conclusion that parties may refer to your order of May 13 is incomplete. Since this matter deals with our Interrogatories Set VI, this represents an element of Discovery that has not been brought to completion.

D. For any meeting in which I participate, I find an agenda necessary to ensure a useful discussion, with items assigned to the specific individuals who will speak to these, and with advance information distributed in advance so that all parties can be fully prepared. This agenda would be constructed in advance and by agreement of all parties so that all can come fully prepared.


7. Using the above criteria, what is the Agenda for the prehearing conference you would like to hold?
