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Dear Secretary Chiavetta:

In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 19, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Metropolitan Edison Company ("Met-Ed"). Met-Ed initiated discovery on November 20, 2018, during the mediation process. Ms. Wallace did not respond to Met-Ed's discovery. Rather, the Complainant submitted a letter on December 10, 2018 wherein she requested additional time and appeared to object to certain questions. Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") Jeffery A. Watson granted Ms. Wallace an extension until January 4, 2019 to submit objections and January 14, 2019 to provide responses. On January 1, 2019, Ms. Wallace submitted objections, and, on January 14, 2019, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Compel. On January 14, 2019, an additional extension request was submitted on Ms. Wallace's behalf. On January 23, 2019, ALJ Watson granted the Motion to Compel, denied Ms. Wallace's objections and directed her to submit responses no later than February 7, 2019. On January 29, 2019, ALJ Watson denied Ms. Wallace's request for an extension as the prior order already provided additional time. Ms. Wallace failed to timely respond to Met-Ed's discovery and, on February 15, 2019, an additional extension request was submitted on behalf of Ms. Wallace. On February 19, 2019, ALJ Watson entered an Interim Order directing Ms. Wallace to respond to Met-Ed's discovery no later than February 25, 2019, noting that no additional extensions would be provided. On February 19, 2019, Ms. Wallace provided incomplete responses and reiterated her objections which were previously denied.

Further, Ms. Wallace has failed to provide notification of her expert and factual witnesses in accordance with the December 19, 2018 Interim Order. Met-Ed timely provided notice of its expert and factual witnesses.

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Due to Ms. Wallace's lack of complete response to discovery and other procedural deadlines, as well as her multiple requests to withdraw the Formal Complaint, Met-Ed filed a Motion to Dismiss on April 23, 2019. The Motion remains pending.

At this point, Met-Ed believes that a ruling on its Motion to Dismiss is appropriate. In the alternative, Met-Ed suggests that it may be valuable for a prehearing conference to be set for this matter in order to determine Ms. Wallace's intent in moving her complaint forward.


