GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

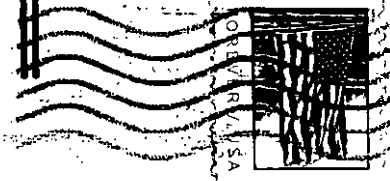
