In accordance with the Interim Order issued on December 21, 2018 in the above-referenced matter, this letter serves as a status report on behalf of Pennsylvania Electric Company ("Penelec"). Discovery has been completed and a prehearing conference was held on March 21, 2019. As a result of the prehearing conference, on March 22, 2019, an Interim Order was entered which provides written testimony deadlines in addition to the litigation schedule set for in the Interim Order entered December 21, 2018.

At this point, Penelec believes that an evidentiary hearing should be scheduled once the written testimony deadlines have passed. Based on representations made by Ms. Hazen regarding her lack of witnesses, Penelec believes that one day should be sufficient to conclude evidentiary hearings. To that end, Penelec advises that its witnesses are not all available on the same day in July, but they are available in August 2019 on the same day for hearings as follows: August 21, 22, 28, and 29.

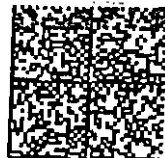
